KYABRAM CEMETERY

The first known burial in the KYABRAM CEMETERY was that of Mr. Peter Clark who died on 14.9.1907 and was buried on 16.9.1907.

It has been difficult to find those buried in the KYABRAM CEMETERY pre 1944 if they did not have a Tombstone, as the records were destroyed by fire in 1944.
